CEO Günter Geyer awarded honorary doctorate

At a special ceremony, **Vienna Insurance Group CEO Günter Geyer** received an **honorary doctorate** from the **University of Economics in Bratislava**.

Günter Geyer became a member of the Managing Board of Slovakian insurer Kooperativa when it was founded in 1990, and has been Chairman of the company's Supervisory Board since 1998.
